10-YEAR-OLD WINE REPORT 2020

## INTRODUCTION

Just how well do modern-era South African wines perform as they get older? One of the most important measures of great wine is that it should be age-worthy, that is it should become more pleasurable and more interesting to drink with time in the bottle and the annual 10-Year-Old Wine Report sets out to examine precisely this.



## **KEY FINDINGS**

2010 was a testing vintage due to the constant fluctuations in weather conditions throughout – a cool, wet spring caused uneven budding in many regions while summer months were exceptionally dry and windy, the heat wave at the beginning of March 2010 which lasted longer than a week going down in the annals.

Even so, the turn-out of wines for this tasting wasn't bad – 74 wines from 33 producers (compared to 92 entries from 42 producers when the 2009 vintage was reviewed last year and 56 entries from 27 producers from the 2008 vintage the year before). Of the 74 entries, 13 were white wines, 53 reds, three Noble Late Harvest and five fortified.

How did the wines shape up? 39.2% of the line-up (a total of 29 wines) rated 90 points or higher on the 100-point quality scale compared to 47.8% last year when the much celebrated 2009 vintage featured. Only 32% of the reds rated 90-plus confirming the commonly held belief that 2010 wasn't the greatest year for wines made from dark-skinned varieties.

Top performing cellars overall were Nederburg with seven wines to rate 90-plus, Tokara with four and Neil Ellis with three. The highest scoring wine overall was the Delaire Graff Cape Vintage 2010 on 93 points.

A general observation. Those "dry and windy" conditions in the lead-up to harvest seem to have taken their toll on the resulting wines. While the white wines generally showed well enough, they didn't have quite the clarity and brightness that a collector might hope for. The reds, meanwhile, tended to present as very ripe and full bodied. The more successful wines have a sturdiness about them rather than finesse or charm while the less successful wines appeared unduly advanced and, in some cases, oxidised.

Of the top four reds, which together rated 92 points, alcohols range from 14.72% in the case of Nederburg The Brew Master 2010 to 15.06% in the case of Ernie Els Signature 2010 – whatever else you might say about them, these are not shy wines (see tasting notes below).

Among these top perfomers was the Le Riche Cabernet Sauvignon Reserve 2010 which rated 5 Stars in the Cabernet Sauvignon Report of 2013, the tasting note then as follows: "Dark fruit, iodine and pencil shavings on the nose. Hugely concentrated but still balanced – lively acidity and silky tannins. Powerful and very long on the finish. Great focus for all its undoubted size." Clearly, 2010 was a vintage to test a winemaker's savvy and if he or she got it right, then something of great impact resulted.

Delaire Graff, as the producer of the highest scoring wine overall, received a bottle of GS Cabernet 1966 worth approximately R30 000 from Amorim Cork.



# JUDGING PROCEDURES

The judging panel was chaired by myself and further consisted of two trusted colleagues, namely Roland Peens and James Pietersen, both of Wine Cellar, Cape Town merchants and cellarers of fine wine. We tasted blind, ratings done according to the 100-point system. Final scores were awarded on the basis of discussion that involved retasting where necessary rather than relying solely on arithmetic averaging.

## TASTINGS NOTES

**RED** 

Ernie Els Signature 2010

Alc: 15.06% RS: 3.6g/l TA: 5.9g/l pH:3.48

60% Cabernet Sauvignon, 25% Merlot, 5% Cabernet Franc, 5% Petit Verdot and 5% Malbec. Matured for 20 months in French oak, 100% new. Red and black fruit, violets and pencil shavings on the nose while the palate is full bodied and smooth textured – a luscious wine yet not short of freshness.



Le Riche Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon 2010

Alc: 15.0% RS: 2.0g/I TA: 6.2g/I pH: 3.76

Matured for 24 months in French oak, 70% new. Top notes of flowers and herbs before black and blue fruit plus graphite on the nose. The palate is super-full with plenty of sweet, juicy fruit to go with smooth tannins, the finish perhaps slightly hot — holding well nevertheless.



Nederburg
Private Bin R163 Cabernet Sauvignon 2010

Alc: 14.88% RS: 3.33g/I TA: 5.8g/I pH: 3.5

Matured for 18 months in a combination of new, second- and third-fill barrels. Cassis, some leafiness and pencil shavings on the nose. The palate is dense and full with a lovely line of acidity, the finish long and very dry — classic SA Cab.



Nederburg
The Brew Master 2010

Alc: 14.72% RS: 3.29g/l TA: 6.01g/l pH: 3.29

81% Cabernet Sauvignon, 9% Merlot, 6% Malbec and 4% Petit Verdot. Matured for 18 months in a combination of new, second-and third-fill barrels. Red and black fruit plus some floral perfume to go with graphite and a little earthiness. Plenty of power on the palate but not short of intricacy or freshness, the tannins still nicely grippy.



#### **SWEET**

Nederburg
Private Bin Eminence 2010

Alc: 10.33% RS: 188g/I TA: 7.0g/I pH: 3.38

100% Muscat de Frontignan. Marmalade, caramel, a hint of mint and other herbs on the nose. Deep and intense on the palate — unctuous in texture and decadently sweet.



#### **FORTIFIED**

Delaire Graff
Cape Vintage 2010

Alc: 19.5% RS: 85.7g/l TA: 5.3g/l pH: 3.92

55% Touriga Nacional, 45% Tinta Barocca. Elegant and refined including flowers and herbs plus red and black berries while the palate shows great focus and balance — good fruit definition, bright acidity and firm but fine tannins. Intense but not weighty, this still has many years ahead of it.



Boplaas
Cape Vintage Reserve Port 2010

Alc: 18.5% RS: 101.5g/l TA: 5.8g/l pH: 3.73

80% Touriga Nacional, 18% Tinta Barocca and 2% Souzao. Black and blue fruit, chocolate and a little earthiness on the nose. The palate is full and rich — great depth of fruit and a comforting warmth to the finish.
