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ABOUT THE WINEMAG.CO.ZA TASTING PROGRAMME 2021



Winemag.co.za is set to produce 14 category reports over the course of the year with multinational financial services company Prescient as sponsor. Each report will be based on the outcome of a blind tasting of wines entered within a specific category.

A report includes key findings, tasting notes for the top wines, buyer's guide and scores on the 100-point quality scale for all wines entered. Upon release, producers can purchase both Top 10 and regular rating stickers – consumers are encouraged to look out for these in the retail environment.

The year culminates in a gala event when the individual best wine in each category will be celebrated. These top-performing wines will subsequently be shown at tastings in both Johannesburg and London.



JUDGING PROCEDURES

The judging panel was chaired by me and further consisted of two trusted colleagues, namely wine writer Malu Lambert and James Pietersen of Wine Cellar, Cape Town merchants and cellarers of fine wine. We tasted blind, labels out of sight. Ratings were done according to the 100-point system, final scores awarded on the basis of discussion that involved retasting where necessary rather than relying solely on arithmetic averaging.

KEY FINDINGS

Twenty years ago, much was made of the Shiraz/ Syrah dichotomy, two names for the same grape variety but the former associated with Australia and the latter with the Rhône region of France, wines labelled as Shiraz supposedly richer, riper and more full-bodied than those labelled as Syrah.

Today the picture is more complicated, Shiraz proving extremely versatile in the Cape with good examples not limited to any specific growing region. In addition, it responds well to a wine variety of winemaking approaches so that there are many contrasting but equally legitimate renditions for the consumer to choose from

For this year's category report, there were 96 entries from 75 producers with 50 (52%) rating 90-plus on the 100-point quality scale. The district with the most wines represented was Stellenbosch with 26 but there were wines from as far afield Sondagskloof (Brunia) and Sutherland Karoo (Mount Sutherland) and almost everything in between.

Looking specifically at the Top 10, four wines come from Stellenbosch, two from Swartland, one each from Elim and Robertson and two are multi-site blends. As for stylistics, alcohols vary from a relatively light 13.13% in the case of Harry Hartman Somesay Syrah 2020 to a potent 15.05% in the case of Rust en Vrede Single Vineyard 2017 while oaking regimes extend from none at all (Leeuwenkuil Shiraz 2020) to significant (DeMorgenzon Reserve Syrah 2017 spending 10 months in 300-litre French oak barrels, 30% new before a further 10 months in 3 000-litre foudre, for instance). The amount of whole-bunch fermentation (intact rather than destemmed bunches included in the fermenter) is another important determinant of the final outcome and again some winemakers are more enthusiastic about applying this technique than others.

The point of all this is to say that South African Syrah can no longer be neatly pigeonholed. Expect everything from delicate, very fine to ultra-glossy, rich wines and the Shiraz/Syrah distinction is no longer really a clue to what's inside the bottle.

Price also differs drastically. The average for the Top 10 is R376 a bottle but ranges from R75 for Du Toitskloof 2018 to R1 100 for Rust en Vrede Single Vineyard Syrah 2017 and the trick becomes to match each wine to the appropriated drinking occasion – readers of the report are urged to go beyond the scores and read the tasting notes!



TOP 10 TASTING NOTES



Harry Hartman Somesay Syrah 2020 R295

Total production: 2 648 bottles Abv: 13.13%

Grapes from Cederberg and Stellenbosch. 50% whole-bunch fermentation. Matured for 11 months in a combination of second- and third-fill 225-litre barrels plus a 1000-litre foudre. Extraordinarily fragrant on the nose with notes of violets, red currant, raspberry and pomegranate, fresh herbs and white pepper. The palate is supremely elegant with lovely fruit expression, bright acidity and powdery tannins, the finish long and saline.





Zandvliet Hill of Enon 2019 R402

Total production: 3 855 bottles Abv: 14.25%

30% whole-bunch fermentation. Matured in older French and American oak barrels for 18 months. Complex aromatics including red and black berries, musk, a slight meaty note, pepper and spice while the palate is rich but balanced with a dense core of fruit, bright acidity and fine tannins. A wine of both presence and intricacy.



De Grendel Elim 2019 R900 per Magnum

Total production: 2 280 magnums Abv: 13.96%

30% whole-bunch fermentation. Matured for 13 months in older oak. The nose is inviting with notes of red and black berries, fynbos, olive brine and white pepper while the palate has intensity of flavour without being weighty and is also wonderfully harmonious – pure and fresh with fine tannins.









Du Toitskloof 2018 875

Total production: 85 000 bottles Abv: 14%

Grapes from Breedekloof and Swartland. Fermented and matured for 12 months using a mixture of barrels and staves. Pretty overtones of flowers and fynbos before red berries and white pepper on the nose before a palate that's light-bodied with appealing fruit expression, bright acidity and powdery tannins – succeeds handsomely on account of its modesty.



Leeuwenkuil 2020 **R95**

Total production: 250 000 bottles Abv: 13.5%

Fermented and matured in stainless steel tank. Seductively perfumed with notes of red berries, flowers, herbs and white pepper while the palate is light and energetic - striking purity of fruit, fresh acidity and a super-dry finish.



Leeuwenkuil Heritage Syrah 2018 R400

Total production: 2 500 bottles Abv: 13.3%

Grapes from two vineyards on schist. Matured for 12 months in older oak. Red and black berries, fynbos, flowers and pepper on the nose while the palate has excellent fruit concentration, bright acidity and firm but not astringent tannins. No shortage of energy for all its density.









Rust en Vrede Single Vineyard Syrah 2017 R1100

Total production: 2 875 bottles Abv: 15.05%

10% whole-bunch fermentation. Matured for 16 months in 500-litre French oak barrels, 50% new. Compelling aromatics of black berries, olive, lavender, dried herbs and pepper while the palate is full-bodied and intensely flavoured – plenty of fruit power, bright acidity and nicely grippy tannins.



DeMorgenzon Reserve Syrah 2017

R430

Total production: 5 800 bottles and 160 magnums Abv: 14.5%

Small percentage whole-bunch fermentation. Matured for 10 months in 300-litre French oak barrels, 30% new before a further 10 months in 3 000-litre foudre. Black berries and herbs plus subtle undertones of earth and tar. The palate is rich and luscious – good depth of fruit, bright acidity and tannins that are firm in the best sense.



Kruger Family Reserve 2017 (Stellenview Premium Wines) R205

Total production: 15 000 bottles Abv: 14.15%

Matured for 18 months in mostly French oak, 30% new. Red and black berries, fynbos and pepper on the nose while the palate shows concentrated fruit, lemon-like acidity and powdery tannins. Well balanced with a nice tension about it.









Rust en Vrede Estate Vineyards Syrah 2019 R320

Total production: 40 050 bottles Abv: 14.02%

15% whole-bunch fermentation. Matured for 18 months in 500-litre French oak barrels, 16% new. Top notes of floral perfume and fynbos before red and black berries plus pepper on the nose. The palate is concentrated and fresh with crunchy tannins. Lovely fruit definition, poise and length.
