ABOUT THE WINEMAG.CO.ZA TASTING PROGRAMME 2021



Winemag.co.za is set to produce 14 category reports over the course of the year with multinational financial services company Prescient as sponsor. Each report will be based on the outcome of a blind tasting of wines entered within a specific category.

A report includes key findings, tasting notes for the top wines, buyer's guide and scores on the 100-point quality scale for all wines entered. Upon release, producers can purchase both Top 10 and regular rating stickers – consumers are encouraged to look out for these in the retail environment.

The year culminates in a gala event when the individual best wine in each category will be celebrated. These top-performing wines will subsequently be shown at tastings in both Johannesburg and London.

JUDGING PROCEDURES

The judging panel was chaired by me and further consisted of two trusted colleagues, namely Roland Peens and James Pietersen of Wine Cellar, Cape Town merchants and cellarers of fine wine. We tasted blind, labels out of sight. Ratings were done according to the 100-point system, final scores awarded on the basis of discussion that involved retasting where necessary rather than relying solely on arithmetic averaging.

KEY FINDINGS

This year's Prescient Chardonnay Report attracted 93 entries from 67 producers. With 51 or 55% of the line-up rating 90-plus on the 100-point quality scale, this was a good showing for the category but not quite as good as last year where 68% of the line-up were 90-points or above. This time around most entries were from 2020 whereas last year, it was 2019 to the fore and the panel's feeling was that 2020 is a slightly lesser vintage when it comes to Chardonnay, the wines not having the same fruit concentration that marked 2019.

As is well-known, Chardonnay is highly malleable in the cellar and responds well to a variety of winemaking techniques. That said, some of the more premium examples in this tasting often looked a little overdone, clean fruity aromas and flavours replaced by honeyed, waxy characters – the suspicion being that in attempting to build in extra complexity to justify a higher price tag, elegance and freshness are being lost. Wines that ought to be capable of maturing over at least a five-year period already show signs of tiring and it is hoped that the vexed issue of premo (premature oxidation) that dogged Burgundy not so long ago is not starting to feature here.

At the other end of the spectrum, there were some rather plain wines, not commercially unacceptable but certainly lacking any real distinction. Chardonnay is, of course, nothing if not adaptable and it can make pleasant enough wine under all sorts of growing conditions.

Generally, however, local Chardonnay seems to achieve the best fruit expressions from vineyards planted in cooler areas. Out of this year's Top 10, three examples were from famously cool Elgin and one was a Stellenbosch-Elgin blend. In addition, Ceres Plateau, Constantia and Hemel-en-Aarde Ridge, which again might all be considered cool climate growing areas, also featured.

The average price of the 51 wines to rate 90-plus is R266 a bottle and of the Top 10 is R273. Offering the best quality relative to price is Franschoek Cellar Our Town Hall Unoaked 2021 with a rating of 91 and selling for R72.50 a bottle.

TOP 10 TASTING NOTES



Constantia Uitsig Reserve 2020

R250

Total production: 3 000 bottles Abv: 12.41%

Fermented and matured in 600-litre barrels, 10% new. The nose shows a hint of struck-match reduction before citrus, red apple and fynbos as well as a touch of vanilla. Extraordinary depth to the palate - super-concentrated fruit, big acidity and a dry finish.



Delaire Graff Banghoek Reserve 2020

R325

Total production: 15 500 bottles Abv: 14.25%

Matured for 10 months in 225-litre barrels, 40% new. No malolactic fermentation. Citrus, some leesy complexity and vanilla on the nose while the palate is rich but balanced – dense fruit and well-integrated acidity before a savoury finish. A powerful wine with layers of flavour that's also thick textured in the best sense.



Neil Ellis Whitehall Elgin 2020

R295

Total production: 12 212 bottles Abv: 13%

Fermented and matured for nine months in 228-litre barrels, 30% new. 30% went through malolactic fermentation. Flowers, herbs, peach and citrus on the nose while the palate shows good fruit concentration and bright acidity before a savoury finish. Well balanced with plenty of detail.





Paul Cluver Village 2020

R120

Total production: 40 740 bottles Abv: 12.5%

Fermented and matured for seven months in a combination of 2 500-litre foudre, older barrels and tank. The nose shows some struck-match reduction before pear, peach, citrus and herbs while the palate is lean, fresh and very dry. Pure and precise.



De Grendel Op die Berg 2020

R300

Total production: 13 400 bottles Abv: 13.02%

Fermented and matured for five months in 225-litre barrels, one-third new. A hint of reduction before peach, citrus and herbs on the nose while the palate shows pure fruit and zippy acidity before a long, dry finish. Plenty of depth but equally wonderfully poised.



Eikendal 2019

R225

Total production: 6 000 bottles Abv: 12.5%

40% own grapes, 20% Lyndedoch and 40% Elgin. Spontaneous fermentation begun in tank and finished in barrel. Matured for some 12 months in 500-litre barrels, 30% new. Complex aromatics with yeasty, waxy notes preceding pear, peach and lemon as well as some oak spice. The palate is medium bodied and well balanced. Carefully assembled, this is layered and long.





La Vierge Jezebel 2020

R158

Total production: 14 382 bottles Abv: 13.9%

Matured for eight months in 500-litre barrels, 20% new. A hint of reduction before citrus and vanilla plus flowers and herbs in the background while the palate shows great depth of fruit matched by bright acidity, the finish long and dry. Harmonious and detailed.



Môreson FYM 2020

R390

Total production: 1 200 bottles Abv: 12.49%

Grapes from a 0.28ha block planted to the rare CY18 clone. Matured for 11 months in 300-litre barrels, a third new. A floral top note before lime and lemon on the nose while the palate is lean with racy acidity and a pithy finish. A wine of particular vibrancy.



Oak Valley Groenlandberg 2020

R255

Total production: 7 000 bottles Abv: 13.41%

Fermented and aged for 10 months in 300-litre barrels, 25% new. Attractive aromatics of pear, white peach and citrus plus herbs and some light reduction. The palate is tightly wound with good fruit concentration, bright acidity and a dry finish.





Warwick The White Lady 2020

R390

Total production: 25 000 bottles Abv: 13.5%

Grapes from three vineyards, two on the Helderberg and one on the Simonsberg. Matured for nine months in 228-litre barrels, 23% new. A hint of reduction before citrus, almond and vanilla on the nose. The palate is rich but balanced – clean fruit and a good line of acidity before a deeply savoury finish.
