

ABOUT THE WINEMAG.CO.ZA TASTING PROGRAMME 2022

Winemag.co.za is set to produce a series of category reports over the course of the year with multinational financial services company Prescient as sponsor. Each report will be based on the outcome of a blind tasting of wines entered within a specific category.

A report includes key findings, tasting notes for the top wines, buyer's guide and scores on the 100-point quality scale for all wines entered. Upon release, producers can purchase both Top 10 and regular rating stickers – consumers are encouraged to look out for these in the retail environment.

JUDGING PROCEDURES

The judging panel was chaired by me and further consisted of two trusted colleagues, namely Ndaba Dube, Food & Beverage Operations Manager at the President Hotel, Cape Town and Spencer Fondaumiere, chairman of the South African Sommelier Association.

We tasted blind, labels out of sight. Ratings were done according to the 100-point system, final scores awarded on the basis of discussion that involved retasting where necessary rather than relying solely on arithmetic averaging.

KEY FINDINGS

For this Sauvignon Blanc Report sponsored multinational financial services company Prescient, there were 94 entries from 71 producers with 47 (50%) rating 90-plus on the 100-point quality scale. In addition, there were 10 examples of single-variety Semillon and 18 Sauv-Sem blends entered.

In contrast with previous reports, the distinction between unwooded and wooded Sauvignon Blanc was dispensed with on the basis that an ever-increasing number of producers at the topend are choosing to use some sort of alternative to stainless steel tank during fermentation and maturation, whether partially or entirely, to build complexity in the final wine.

The addition of Semillon as a tool to add an extra dimension to straight Sauvignon Blanc is also more and more commonplace. As mentioned above, there were 18 wines specifically labelled as blends (Sauvignon Blanc not necessarily the majority component) that were entered but out of the single-variety Top 10, three contain a portion of Semillon amounting to 15% or less as allowed by Wine and Spirit Board regulations.

Yes, Sauvignon Blanc has become ubiquitous on account of how readily it makes aromatic, crisp but ultimately unchallenging wines intended to have mass appeal and yes, these are probably not worth consideration by highly involved wine enthusiasts but to dismiss the variety out of hand is short-sighted as this Report reveals.

As ever, Sauvignon Blanc responds well to cooler climate conditions, whether this be due to vineyards being located close to the sea or at altitude - Constantia, Darling, Durbanville, the Cape South Coast plus certain locations in Stellenbosch all produced wines that showed well.

When it comes to winemaking, meanwhile, there is plenty of freethinking in evidence. The Diemersdal team, for instance, saw fit to employ spontaneous fermentation and four days of skin contact before maturation lasting 11 months in older oak when it came to Wildhorse Shoe 2021. Brad Paton of Buitenverwachting used a selection of five yeast strains in creating his 2022. And there's very little that's predictable or formulaic about the other top-performing wines.

Sauvignon Blanc, when sited correctly and then treated with both care and imagination in the cellar, is producing wines that are just as intense and complex as the best examples of Chardonnay or Chenin Blanc. In particular, the perennial criticism of Sauvignon Blanc that its acidity is too hard and aggressive is now invalidated by wines that have the fruit weight to provide balance. In addition, wines premised on having a very high pyrazine count (the chemical compounds that gives Sauvignon Blanc its "green" character and measured in nanograms per litre) to make an impression seem to be increasingly out of fashion. In their place are wines of far more nuance and detail.

Suffice to say, being a Sauvignon Blanc naysayer no longer identifies you as hip and unconventional but rather it's a sign of being dogmatically closed minded if not radically out of touch.

The average price of the 47 wines to rate 90-plus is R149 a bottle and of the Top 10 is R194. Offering the best quality relative to price is Robertson 2022 with a rating of 92 and selling for R65 a bottle.

Kershaw Wines, as producer of the Sauv-Sem blend judged best overall, wins a new 225-litre Sylvain Blanc barrel worth €941 (the equivalent of R16 075 at the time of writing) from Tonnellerie Sylvain.



SAUVIGNON BLANC - TOP 10 TASTING NOTES



Cape Point Vineyards Reserve 2020

Price: R220

Total Production: 9 000 bottles Abv 14%

Fermented and matured for 15 months in older oak. Complex aromatics with notes of hay, fynbos, citrus, white peach and a hint of blackcurrant while the palate shows great fruit purity matched by punchy acidity, the finish long and savoury. Layered and long, this shows great refinement.





Diemersdal Wild Horseshoe 2021

Price: R265

Total Production: I 300 bottles Abv I 3.34%

Four days of skin contact. Spontaneously fermented and matured for 11 months in older 500-litre barrels. Peach, blackcurrant, dried herbs and spice on the nose while the palate is rich and thick textured – good fruit definition and well-integrated acidity before a savoury finish.





Buitenverwachting 2022

Price: R120

Total Production: 220 000 bottles Abv 13.37%

Fermented using a selection of five yeast strains. A complex nose with top notes of flowers and fynbos plus a little flinty reduction before pear, peach and lime. The palate, meanwhile, has good fruit concentration and zippy acidity before a dry finish. Focused and elegant, this wine has a lovely energy about it.







Iona Elgin Highlands Wild Ferment 2021

Price: R240

Total Production: 3 400 bottles Abv 13.2%

Spontaneously fermented and matured for 11 months in older 500-litre barrels before a further three months in tank. Exotic aromatics of hay, dried herbs, peach, blackcurrant and pineapple plus some leesy complexity while the palate is rich with tangy acidity and a savoury finish. A dramatic wine.





Kleine Zalze Family Reserve 2021

Price: R260

Total Production: 5 143 bottles Abv 13.66%

Grapes from Darling and Durbanville. 50% fermented in new 400-litre barrels, while maturation lasted six months. A pronounced herbal note plus citrus, peach and some leesy complexity on the nose while the palate is rich and forceful – dense fruit plays off against tangy acidity before a savoury finish.





Mellish Family Vineyards Bakenkop Blanc Fumé 2020

Price: R220

Total Production: I 068 bottles Abv I2.6%

90% fermented and matured in 300-litre barrels of which a third were new and 10% fermented on the skins for eight days. White peach, blackcurrant and fennel plus vanilla and some waxy character on the nose while the palate has real presence with good fruit density and coated acidity – rich and thick textured.





The Smuggler's Boot 2021 (Richard Kershaw Wines)

Price: R195

Total Production: 2 I57 bottles Abv I3.37%

88% Sauvignon Blanc, 12% Semillon. Grapes from Elgin and Hemel-en-Aarde Ridge. Some flinty reduction before peach and blackcurrant on the nose while the palate shows dense fruit and well-integrated acidity before a gently savoury finish. It's a wine with plenty of power but also nuance.





Zevenwacht 2022

Price: R105

Total Production: 26 666 bottles Abv 13.87%

90% Sauvignon Blanc, 10% Semillon. Five months of lees contact. A herbal top note before citrus, peach, green melon and some yeasty character. The palate is rich and thick textured with plenty of flavour and well-integrated acidity.





Zorgvliet Single Vineyard 2021

Price: R130

Total Production: 2 I50 bottles Abv I3.73%

Grapes from a 3.2ha block on steeply terraced, south-facing slope. 10% fermented in second-fill 500-litre barrels. Citrus blossom, herbs, lime and white peach on the nose while the palate is well balanced with pure fruit counteracting snappy acidity. Fleshy in texture with some white pepper bite to the finish.








Groot Constantia 2022

Price: R185

Total Production: 38 420 bottles Abv 13.33%

93% Sauvignon Blanc and 7% Semillon. Four months on the lees. Pretty aromatics with top notes of flowers and herbs before white peach, lime and a hint of blackcurrant. The palate is well balanced – pure fruit and a creamy texture, the acidity nicely integrated. Layers of flavour, the finish long and dry.





SEMILLON - TOP 3 TASTING NOTES



Wildeberg Semillon 2021

Price: R360

Total Production: 4 498 bottles Abv 13%

Grapes from Franschhoek old vines. Spontaneously fermented in new and older oak. A wonderfully complex nose showing top notes of thatch and fynbos before citrus and peach while the palate has a dense core of fruit, bright acidity and a saline finish. Precise and detailed, this is very classy.





Nitida Semillon 2021

Price: R130

Total Production: 4 400 bottles Abv 14.47%

70% of the juice fermented in French oak, 80% new. Maturation lasted six months. Top notes of floral perfume and hay before citrus, stone fruit, spice and some bee's wax. The palate is rich and broad with great texture and moderate acidity, the finish gently savoury. Full of flavour.





Benguela Cove Catalina Semillon 2019

Price: R650

Total Production: I 400 bottles Abv I3.8%

Matured for nine months in 500-litre barrels, 35% new. A hint of reduction before citrus, peach and blackcurrant and a touch of herbs. Excellent fruit expression matched by a great line of acidity, the finish long and dry. Not too lean and very well balanced.





SAUV-SEM BLENDS - TOP 5 TASTING NOTES



Kershaw GPS Series Cape South Coast Semillon Sauvignon Blanc 2020

Price: R395

Total Production: 3 950 bottles Abv 13.22%

52% Semillon from Hemel-en-Aarde, 48% Sauvignon Blanc from Elgin. Semillon finished fermentation in barrels of which two-thirds were new, the Sauvignon Blanc fermented in tank. Maturation lasted four months. Citrus, white peach and blackcurrant on the nose while the palate has a dense core of fruit and punchy acidity before a dry finish. A seamless wine with just the right amount of weight and texture.





Wade Bales Regional Series Constantia White 2020

Price: R250

Total Production: 3 787 bottles Abv 13.83%

78% Sauvignon Blanc, 22% Semillon. Grapes from Beau Constantia, Buitenverwachting, Constantia Glen, Constantia Royale, Constantia Uitsig, Groot Constantia, Klein Constantia and Steenberg. Fermented and matured for seven months in barrel. A top note of fynbos before lime, naartjie, white peach and blackcurrant on the nose while the palate has pure fruit and racy acidity before a finish that is long and dry. Great complexity and energy.





Coterie by Wildeberg Semillon & Sauvignon Blanc 2020

Price: R295

Total Production: 15 528 bottles Abv 14%

80% Semillon, 20% Sauvignon Blanc. Semillon was fermented in 600-litre French and Austrian oak of which 36% was new, while the Sauvignon Blanc was fermented in stainless-steel tanks, maturation lasting 10 months altogether. A top note of hay before stone fruit and blackcurrant plus some waxiness on the nose while the palate is rich and smooth textured with well-integrated acidity and a savoury finish.







Constantia Glen Two 2020

Price: R295

Total Production: 15 528 bottles Abv 14%

71% Sauvignon Blanc, 29% Semillon. Fermented and matured for eight months in 600-litre barrels (French and Austrian oak as well as acacia) plus a few clay amphorae. Hay, herbs, lime and white peach on the nose. Seemingly light bodied and rather taut – pure fruit and zippy acidity before a saline finish. Precisely made.





Groot Constantia Gouverneurs Reserve White 2019

Price: R525

Total Production: 2 756 bottles Abv 13.26%

60% Sauvignon Blanc, 40% Semillon. Fermented and matured for 10 months in French oak barrels, 50% new. Herbs and sea-breeze before yellow apple and stone fruit plus some waxy character on the nose while the palate is rich and broad but not short of freshness thanks to a nice line of acidity. Well structured with a savoury finish.
