

#### ABOUT THE WINEMAG.CO.ZA TASTING PROGRAMME 2022

Winemag.co.za produced a series of category reports over the course of the year with multinational financial services company Prescient as sponsor. Each report was based on the outcome of a blind tasting of wines entered within a specific category.

A report includes key findings, tasting notes for the top wines, buyer's guide and scores on the 100-point quality scale for all wines entered. Upon release, producers can purchase both Top 10 and regular rating stickers – consumers are encouraged to look out for these in the retail environment.

# JUDGING PROCEDURES

The judging panel was chaired by me and further consisted of two trusted colleagues, namely James Pietersen and Jolette Steyn, both of Wine Cellar, Cape Town merchants and cellarers of fine wine.

We tasted blind, labels out of sight. Ratings were done according to the 100-point system, final scores awarded on the basis of discussion that involved retasting where necessary rather than relying solely on arithmetic averaging.

### **KEY FINDINGS**

Is the quality of Chardonnay in decline, even if only slightly? This year's category report sponsored by Prescient attracted 80 entries from 59 producers with 43 (54%) rating 90-plus on the 100-point quality scale. Solid enough but in 2021, 55% of the line-up made the 90-point threshold and the year before, it was 68%.

It's somewhat difficult to make sense of this downward trend in quality. By far the most entries were from the 2021 vintage, cooler and later than usual, and generally considered good as a result but perhaps we are seeing the less easily measurable but nevertheless profound impact of climate change.

Without wishing to focus on the negatives too much, the Top 10 are outstanding with five wines on 94 and another five on 93.
Elgin property Oak Valley boosts its already high reputation with no less than three wines featuring (and one just outside) while Franschhoek fares well with three examples in the mix, followed by Constantia and Stellenbosch with two each.

What might the defining characteristics of the Top 10 be? The panel was looking to reward purity of fruit, crisp but not seering acidity, the qualities of barrel maturation not too much in evidence.

The less successful examples fall either side of this golden mean being either too neutral or too rich. Some producers are evidently attempting to make Chardonnay sappy and refreshing but end up with something that presents as lacking in concentration and rather nondescript. Others, meanwhile, appear to over-reach themselves — in attempting to achieve both weight and complexity, winemaking imposes itself too much. The clumsy use of oak, malolactic fermentation, and stirring of the lees lend all sorts of secondary character that obscures fruit and can make the resulting wine flabby and listless.

The average price of the 40 wines to rate 90-plus is R272 a bottle and of the Top 10 is R267. Offering the best quality relative to price is Kleine Zalze Cellar Selection Unoaked 2022 with a rating of 92 and selling for R77 a bottle.

Backsberg, as producer of the wine judged best overall, wins a 2BFermControl organic fermentation kit worth approximately R10 500.



### TOP 10 TASTING NOTES



Backsberg Smuggled Vines 2021

Price: R125

Total Production: 2 500 bottles Abv 13.5%

Grapes from Franschhoek. Fermentation started in stainless steel tanks and finished in barrel before maturation lasting 10 months. A top note of blossom before peach and citrus plus some intriguing leesy character on the nose. The palate, meanwhile, is wonderfully precise with a dense core of fruit, bright acidity and a finish that is long and savoury.





Delaire Graff Summercourt 2021

Price: R205

Total Production: 31 536 bottles Abv 13.6%

Fermentation started in stainless steel tanks and finished in older oak barrels before maturation lasting 10 months. Pear, citrus and some struck-match reduction on the nose. The palate has a good core of fruit matched by punchy acidity. Nice texture – not too greasy. Tightly wound with a savoury finish.





La Petite Ferme Barrel Fermented 2021

Price: R235

Total Production: I 266 bottles Abv I 2.37%

Fermented and matured for nine months in 228-litre French oak barrels, 20% new. A top note of honeysuckle before citrus, vanilla and some struck-match reduction on the nose while the palate is particularly vivid – great clarity of fruit and punchy acidity make for a dramatic wine.







## Oak Valley Beneath The Clouds 2021

Price: R130

Total Production: 27 300 bottles Abv 13.8%

Matured for nine months in older oak. The nose shows citrus, green apple, fresh herbs and a hint of reduction while the palate has great fruit purity and freshness before a saline finish. Taut and focused.





Oak Valley Groenlandberg 2021

Price: R260

Total Production: 8 040 bottles Abv 13.26%

Matured for 10 months in French oak, 28% new. The aromatics include a flinty top note before citrus and Granny Smith apple while the palate is tightly wound – great fruit purity and zesty acidity before a savoury finish. This has plenty of reined-in power – good weight and texture but also plenty of detail.





Constantia Uitsig Reserve 2021

Price: R250

Total Production: 3 600 bottles Abv 13.42%

Fermented and matured for seven months in French oak barrels, 33% new. Citrus, vanilla and some buttery complexity on the nose. The palate is rich, round and thick-textured although bright acidity lends verve and the finish is nicely savoury.





## Groot Constantia 2021

Price: R285

Total Production: 24 911 bottles Abv 12.8%

30% fermented spontaneously. Matured for 10 months in French oak, 35% new. Aromatics of citrus, a hint of struck-match reduction and vanilla while the palate is rich and round with lots of flavour and well-integrated acidity.





La Motte 2020

Price: R159

Total Production: 39 600 bottles Abv 12.38%

Fermentation started in stainless steel tanks and finished in 300-litre barrels of which 20% were new, maturation subsequently lasting 12 months. Citrus, oatmeal, vanilla and some leesy complexity on the nose. The palate is rich and full with dense fruit matched by a good line of acidity and a savoury finish. Smooth in texture with layers of flavour.





Oak Valley Tabula Rasa CY548 2020

Price: R700

Total Production: 660 bottles Abv 13.54%

Matured for 10 months in French oak, 50% new. A shy nose with subtle notes of pear, peach and citrus plus a little reduction while the palate has impressive fruit purity and a great line of acidity before a bone-dry finish – wonderfully focused and elegant.





# Waterford Single Vineyard 2019

Price: R320

Total Production: 23 400 bottles Abv I 2%

From a vineyard planted in 1988. Matured for 11 months in 300-litre French oak barrels, 14% new. Pear, peach, citrus and some smoky reduction on the nose while the palate has concentrated fruit and driving acidity before a saline finish. Well balanced and still very youthful.
