

ABOUT THE WINEMAG.CO.ZA TASTING PROGRAMME 2023

Winemag.co.za is set to produce a series of category reports over the course of the year with multinational financial services company Prescient as sponsor. Each report will be based on the outcome of a blind tasting of wines entered within a specific category.

A report includes key findings, tasting notes for the top wines, buyer's guide and scores on the 100-point quality scale for all wines entered. Upon release, producers can purchase both Top 10 and regular rating stickers – consumers are encouraged to look out for these in the retail environment.

JUDGING PROCEDURES

The judging panel was chaired by me and further consisted of two trusted colleagues, namely Ndaba Dube, Food & Beverage Operations Manager at the President Hotel in Cape Town and Spencer Fondaumiere, chairman of the South African Sommelier Association.

We tasted blind, labels out of sight. Ratings were done according to the 100-point system, final scores awarded on the basis of discussion that involved retasting where necessary rather than relying solely on arithmetic averaging.

KEY FINDINGS

This year's Pinotage Report sponsored by multinational financial services company Prescient sees Agter-Paarl cellar Windmeul dominating with three wines in the Top 10. What is even more remarkable is that these three wines are positioned across the range, from entry-level to top-end, demonstrating that the winemaking team can get the best out of the variety while deploying a variety of different styles.

In fact, it was the humble standard-label 2021 (price: R70 a bottle) that rated slightly ahead of the grander Reserve 2020 (R150) and The Legend Collection 2021 (R350) — Winemag.co.za has for some time argued that New Wave Pinotage can easily co-exist alongside Old School Pinotage, that is to say there's place for lighter, fresher renditions of the variety without disregarding those more traditional examples that tend to feature highly concentrated fruit and very firm tannins.

It doesn't get more New School than the Illimis 2022 from Lucinda Heyns, which also placed Top 10. Winemaking involved 100% whole-bunch fermentation before maturation lasting just seven months in older oak. Alcohol, meanwhile, is a mere 12%. It's a gorgeous wine, despite being stylistically a million miles away from category benchmarks like Kanonkop Black Label.

If, however, you are looking for power from your Pinotage, then such examples are certainly still to be found in the Top 10, none more so than Stellenbosch 1679 Old Vine 2020 from Koelenhof – matured for 16 months in 100% new oak and carrying an alcohol of 15.22%, it's full-on.

Pinotage is undeniably controversial but it's not going to go away any time soon — it's South Africa's sixth most planted variety on 6 661ha behind Shiraz and ahead of Chardonnay — and the best way forward is to open up rather than shut down debate about how to get the best out of the variety.

In any event, the overall quality of the line-up tasted this year was encouragingly high, a total of 64 wines from 38 producers entered with 36 (56%) rating 90-plus on the 100-point quality scale.

The average price of the 37 wines to rate 90-plus is R208 a bottle and of the Top 10 is R207. Offering the best quality relative to price is Koelenhof 2021 with a rating of 90 and selling for R65 a bottle.



TOP 10 TASTING NOTES



De Grendel Amandelboord 2022

Price: R300

Total Production: 22 644 bottles Abv 14.56%

Matured for 12 months in French and American oak, 12% new. Enticing aromatics including notes of red and black berries, fynbos, flowers, earth and spice. The palate is medium bodied with a lovely line of acidity and nicely grippy tannins. Pure and energetic.





Mooiplaas 2022

Price: R155

Total Production: II 000 bottles Abv I4%

Matured for 12 months in French oak barrels, 10% new. Fragrant aromatics with top notes of flowers and herbs before red and black berries. Poised and elegant – lovely clarity of fruit, good freshness and powdery tannins.





Windmeul 2021

Price: R70

Total Production: 6 600 bottles Abv 14.54%

From an Agter-Paarl vineyard planted in 2012. Matured for 12 months in older oak. Inviting aromatics of red and black berries, rose and fresh herbs. The palate is medium bodied and wonderfully harmonious – a dense core of fruit, zippy acidity and chalky tannins, a saline quality to the finish.





Diemersdal Reserve 2022

Price: R190

Total Production: 60 000 bottles Abv 14.81%

Matured for 14 months in 225-litre barrels, 40% new. The nose has top notes of flowers and tea leaf before red and black cherry plus vanilla. The palate displays concentrated fruit, lively acidity and smooth tannins. Powerful but balanced.





Warwick The First Lady 2022

Price: R120

Total Production: II6 000 bottles Abv I3%

Matured for 12 months in various types of oak, 8% new. The nose shows red and black cherry, rose and some attractive herbal character. Lean and fresh on the palate with a dry finish. An understated, rather pretty wine.





Windmeul Reserve 2020

Price: RI50

Total Production: 2 900 bottles Abv 14.25%

Grapes from an Agter-Paarl vineyard planted in 1997. Matured for 18 months in first- and second-fill barrels. Plum, black cherry and cassis plus vanilla and spice on the nose. Dense fruit, bright acidity and firm but not coarse tannins. A full-bodied, well-structured wine. Upright and vibrant.







Windmeul The Legend Collection 2021

Price: R350

Total Production: 840 bottles Abv 14.7%

Grapes from an Agter-Paarl vineyard planted in 1997. A barrel selection – matured for 18 months in first-fill barrels. Red and black berries, vanilla and spice on the nose while the palate has good fruit concentration, bright acidity and a nicely grippy finish. A polished wine that has weight and texture without being listless.





Illimis 2022

Price: R248

Total Production: I 380 bottles Aby I2%

100% whole-bunch fermentation before maturation lasting seven months in older oak. Attractive aromatics of red berries, fynbos and flowers while the palate is light and pure with great vibrancy and a salty finish. Succulent with lemon-like acidity and fine tannins.





Stellenbosch 1679 Old Vine 2020

Price: R375

Total Production: 2 300 bottles Aby 15.22%

Grapes from a vineyard planted in 1975. Matured for 16 months in 300-litre barrels, 100% new. A top note of potpourri before red and black berries, vanilla and spice. The palate is rich and broad – sweet fruit and a creamy texture, before a gently savoury finish. Luxuriously styled.





Bruce Jack Reserve Collection 2021

Price: RIII

Total Production: 13 600 bottles Abv 14.5%

Matured for 16 months in barrel, 10% new. Some staves used. Top notes of flowers and herbs before red and black cherry, vanilla, earth and spice. Good fruit concentration, bright acidity and fine tannins. Well balanced, rich and round – a textbook example.
