

ABOUT THE WINEMAG.CO.ZA TASTING PROGRAMME 2023

Winemag.co.za is set to produce a series of category reports over the course of the year with multinational financial services company Prescient as sponsor. Each report will be based on the outcome of a blind tasting of wines entered within a specific category.

A report includes key findings, tasting notes for the top wines, buyer's guide and scores on the 100-point quality scale for all wines entered. Upon release, producers can purchase both Top 10 and regular rating stickers – consumers are encouraged to look out for these in the retail environment.

JUDGING PROCEDURES

The judging panel was chaired by me and further consisted of two trusted colleagues, namely wine writer Malu Lambert and James Pietersen of Wine Cellar, Cape Town merchants and cellarers of fine wine. We tasted blind, labels out of sight. Ratings were done according to the 100-point system, final scores awarded on the basis of discussion that involved retasting where necessary rather than relying solely on arithmetic averaging.

KEY FINDINGS

For this year's Chardonnay Report sponsored by multinational financial services company Prescient, there were 80 entries from 61 producers with 43 (54%) rating 90-plus on the 100-point quality scale.

Wines from 2022 feature prominently in this Report with seven wines in the Top 10 from this vintage (alongside three from 2021) while there were a further 17 to score 90-plus.

As for provenance, Stellenbosch dominates the Top 10 with seven wines from this district followed by Elgin with three. The 2021/2022 growing season is generally viewed positively – above-average cold units in winter, delayed budding in spring and, in turn, a slow ripening process allowed optimal fruit quality (the exception being Swartland which experienced extremely hot weather during harvest but this, of course, not an area known for Chardonnay).

Looking at the line-up as a whole, the best examples show depth of fruit, intricacy of flavour and drive. Less successful are the wines that appear very primary – technically sound but lacking any great distinction. Some producers are clearly attempting to make wines of elegance but often these end up being simple and angular, instead.

Conversely, other wines appeared quite heavily worked. Chardonnay is not necessarily the most naturally expressive variety to be had but it is highly malleable in the cellar. Fermentation and maturation in different sorts of oak barrels; a second, softening malolactic fermentation; and different levels of stirring, or "batonnage", of the lees at the bottom of the barrel are all important techniques applied by winemakers. A crucial part of assessing Chardonnay therefore becomes deciding when do these techniques superimpose themselves to just the right extent and when are they too much.

The average price of the 43 wines to rate 90-plus is R286 a bottle and of the Top 10 is R306. Offering the best quality relative to price is De Wet 2022 with a rating of 90 and selling for R69 a bottle.

Vriesenhof, as producer of the wine judged best overall, wins a 2BFermControl organic fermentation kit worth approximately R11 000.

Vriesenhof 2021

Total Production: I 650 bottles Abv I3.26%

Matured in French oak barrels for 13 month, 10% new. Some flinty reduction before lemon and a hint of vanilla. The palate is pure and focused – excellent depth of fruit matched by driving acidity, the finish possessing a wonderfully pithy quality. Layers of flavour and great length.





Blaauwklippen 2022

Price: R200

Total Production: 5 000 bottles Abv 13.5%

Matured for 11 months in a combination of 228- and 300-litre barrels, 22% new. Lemon, oatmeal plus some yeasty complexity on the nose. The palate is dense and satisfyingly thick textured, fresh acidity providing balance. Full of flavour, the finish long and savoury.





Delaire Graff Terraced Block 2022

Price: R915

Total Production: 4 460 bottles Abv 13.35%

Matured for 10 months in 225-litre barrels, 40% new. Lime, lemon and white peach, a little leesy complexity and spice on the nose. The palate is remarkably harmonious with good fruit weight and texture offset by racy acidity, the finish long and saline.





Lothian of Elgin 2021

Price: R370

Total Production: 10 000 bottles Abv 13.5%

Matured for 11 months in 228-litre barrels, 25% new oak. The nose shows lemon and orange plus some leesy complexity. The palate is forceful in the best sense – concentrated fruit matched by big acidity, the finish long and savoury. Just the right amount of weight and texture.





Oak Valley Groenlandberg 2022

Price: R280

Total Production: 9 400 bottles Abv 13.21%

Matured for 10 months in barrel, 29% new. Attractive aromatics with top notes of flowers and herbs before lime, lemon and green apple, a touch of vanilla and hint of reduction. Dense fruit matched by racy acidity, the finish long and dry. Taut and vibrant now, this should mature with benefit.





Paul Clüver Village 2022

Price: R125

Total Production: 66 000 bottles Abv 12.8%

50% fermented in 2 500-litre oak vats, 36% in older 300-litre barrels, 8% in tank and 6% in concrete egg. Matured for eight months. Lime, lemon, some leesy complexity plus traces of vanilla and spice. Great fruit integrity and punchy acidity before a savoury finish. Complex and balanced.







Bellingham Homestead 2021

Price: RII0

Total Production: 20 000 bottles Abv 13%

60% fermented in older 500-litre barrels and 40% in stainless steel tank. Some struck-match reduction before lemon, orange and pineapple while the palate is juicy, rich and round – has a particular brightness about it.





Delaire Graff Banghoek Reserve 2022

Price: R410

Total Production: 8 020 bottles Aby 13.48%

Matured for 10 months in 225-litre barrels, 40% new. Some struck-match reduction before peach, citrus and dried herbs on the nose. The palate, meanwhile, has lovely clarity of fruit – pure and fresh with a finish that is long and dry.





Journey's End V1 2022

Price: R195

Total Production: 19 200 bottles Abv 13.5%

Matured for nine months, 80% in barrel, 12% in concrete eggs and 8% in amphorae. Complex aromatics of citrus, oatmeal and earth with notes of flowers and herbs in the background while the palate shows pure fruit and bright acidity before a pithy finish. Nicely understated.







Cavalli Reserve 2022

Price: R2I0

Total Production: 6 752 bottles Abv 13%

Matured for 10 months in 225-litre barrels, 25% new. A hint of flinty reduction before citrus, oatmeal and a little nuttiness on the nose. The palate has a nice poise about it with clean fruit, racy acidity and a chalky finish.
