ABOUT THE WINEMAG.CO.ZA TASTING PROGRAMME 2024

Winemag.co.za produces category reports on a regular basis with global financial services company Prescient as sponsor. Each report will be based on the outcome of a blind tasting of wines entered within a specific category.

A report includes key findings, tasting notes for the top wines, buyer's guide and scores on the 100-point quality scale for all wines entered. Upon release, producers can purchase both Top 10 and regular rating stickers – consumers are encouraged to look out for these in the retail environment.

JUDGING PROCEDURES

The judging panel was chaired by me and further consisted of two trusted colleagues, namely Ndaba Dube, director of operations at the President Hotel in Cape Town, and wine writer Malu Lambert.

We tasted blind, labels out of sight. Ratings were done according to the 100-point system, final scores awarded on the basis of discussion that involved retasting where necessary rather than relying solely on arithmetic averaging.

KEY FINDINGS

According to the website
RoseWinesWorldTracking.com, global Rosé
consumption grew from 18.7 million hectolitres
in 2013 to 19.9 million hectolitres in 2018. After
a downward phase between 2019 and 2021,
consumption stabilized in 2022 (at 19.6 million
hectolitres, up 0.5% over 2021). Although it
levelled out, the total consumption of still wine
in general continued to shrink (down 2.6% in
2022). Rosé now accounts for 10% of global still
wine consumption.

It could well be argued that Rosé is more about technique in the cellar than provenance, and yet five of the Top 10 were from Stellenbosch, while three were from Swartland, and one each from Durbanville and Robertson respectively.

Among the Top 10, there was again a lot of varietal diversity in evidence with three wines which might be viewed as Tavel inspired (Vriesenhof 2023 and 2024, Meraki Grenache 2024), two that used Bordeaux varieties (Durbanville Hills Merlot 2024, Zorgvliet Cabernet Franc 2024), one that used Cab combined with Shiraz (Quoin Rock 2024), one that used Chardonnay combined with Pinot Noir (Van Loveren Daydream 2024), one straight Pinotage (Warwick The First Lady), one straight Shiraz (Tokara 2024) and one that defies all convention consisting of Carignan and Touriga Nacional, a blend of the 2022 and 2023 vintages and made in an purposefully oxidative style (Vinevenom Shining No. 3 NV). When it comes to pink, anything goes...

Domestically, dry Rosé remains a very small category. Out of 422.3 million litres of still wine sold in 2023, it made up 5.5 million litres, the equivalent of 1.3% (total Rosé/Blanc de Noir including natural and semi-sweet sales amounted to 53.5 million litres or 12.7%). That said, the best wines in this report are still cheap. The average price of the 22 wines to rate 90-plus is R115 a bottle and of the Top 10 is R122. Best buy is Van Loveren Daydream Chardonnay Pinot Noir 2024 with a rating of 91 and selling for R69 a bottle.



TOP 10 TASTING NOTES



Quoin Rock 2024

Price: R165

Total Production: 7 500 bottles Abv 13.13%

74% Cabernet Sauvignon, 26% Shiraz. Fermented and matured for six months in older 225-litre barrels. Orange, spice and an appealing nutty oxidative note. The palate has a nice vinosity about it – good weight and breadth, tangy acidity and a gently savoury finish.





Vriesenhof 2023

Price: R125

Total Production: 17 000 bottles Abv 12.17%

60% Grenache, 25% Mourvèdre, 15% Shiraz. 50% matured in stainless-steel tank, 50% in old 4,000-litre foudre. Berries, red apple, orange, earth and spice on the nose while the palate is well balanced – good fruit expression, coated acidity and a gently savoury finish.





Warwick The First Lady Dry 2024

Price: R115

Total Production: 14 000 bottles Abv 11.5%

100% Pinotage. Strawberry, orange, earth and spice on the nose. Pure fruit, bright acidity and a lightly grippy finish. Possesses both detail and finesse.





Durbanville Hills Merlot 2024

Price: R90

Total Production: 133 333 bottles Abv 13.63%

100% Merlot. Red berries, orange and fynbos on the nose while the palate shows concentrated fruit, a creamy texture counterbalanced by bright acidity.





Meraki Grenache 2024

Price: R95

Total Production: 4 000 bottles Aby 12.88%

The nose shows flowers, red berries and orange. The palate is well balanced and flavourful – good fruit concentration and fresh acidity before a dry finish.





Van Loveren Daydream Chardonnay Pinot Noir 2024

Price: R69

Total Production: 125 000 bottles Abv 12.15%

94% Chardonnay, 6% Pinot Noir. A top note of blossom before strawberry, apricot, orange and spice on the nose. The palate has good flavour intensity, a pleasantly smooth texture, the acidity tangy, the finish savoury.





Vinevenom Shining No. 3 NV

Price: R190

Total Production: I 300 bottles Abv I 3.4%

80% Carignan, 20% Touriga Nacional. Third release, a blend of the 2022 and 2023 vintages. Made in an oxidative style with some light flor ageing and a maderised component. Complex aromatics of marmalade, stone fruit, nuts, rancio, and spice. The palate is intensely flavoured with tangy acidity and an umami-like finish. Unconventional but delicious!





Vriesenhof 2024

Price: R125

Total Production: 25 000 bottles Abv 12.25%

70% Grenache, 30% Mourvèdre. 50% matured in stainless-steel tank, 50% in old 4,000-litre foudre. A touch of reduction before strawberry orange, fynbos, a nutty character and earth on the nose. The palate has good texture and bright acidity, some pleasing tannic grip to the finish.





Zorgvliet Cabernet Franc 2024

Price: RI30

Total Production: 6 600 bottles Abv 13.75%

Subtle and alluring aromatics of red berries, orange, potpourri and herbs while the palate is juicy and fresh. Well balanced with a nice tension about it.





Tokara 2024

Price: R115

Total Production: 15 000 bottles Abv 12.5%

100% Shiraz. Pretty aromatics including floral perfume, herbs and red berries. The palate is light and delicate with crisp acidity and a long, dry finish.
