

ABOUT THE WINEMAG.CO.ZA TASTING PROGRAMME 2025

Winemag.co.za will release a series of category reports throughout the year with Prescient Fund Services as sponsor. Each report is based on the outcome of a blind tasting of wines entered within a specific category.

A report includes key findings, tasting notes for the top wines, buyer's guide (wines ranked by quality relative to price) and scores on the 100-point quality scale for all wines entered. Upon publication, producers can purchase both Top 10 and regular rating stickers – consumers are encouraged to look out for these in the retail environment.

JUDGING PROCEDURES

The judging panel was chaired by me and further consisted of two trusted colleagues, namely wine writer Malu Lambert and wine and hospitality specialist Francois Rautenbach.

Ratings were done according to the 100-point system, with final scores determined through discussion and retasting when necessary, rather than relying solely on arithmetic averages.

KEY FINDINGS

For this year's Shiraz Report sponsored by financial services company Prescient Fund Services, there were 71 entries from 53 producers with 36 (51%) rating 90-plus on the 100-point quality scale.

The category appears increasingly polarised — if not in the midst of an identity crisis — with the top-performing wines clearly well-conceived, while many of the rest come across as overwrought and lacking finesse.

Standout examples combine fragrant aromatics (red/black berries, flowers, fynbos, pepper) with fruit purity, bright acidity, and fine-grained tannins. Whole-bunch fermentation – partial or complete – is a common thread, lending lift, perfume, and texture. Oak usage skews toward older barrels to preserve elegance over power. Wines are consistently medium-bodied, favouring poise and freshness over overt ripeness or heaviness. Alcohol levels are moderate, reinforcing a style that prizes balance, energy, and finesse. Even the more structured examples avoid excess weight, instead showing seamless integration and refined mouthfeel. Overall, the trend is toward vivid, expressive, and finely structured Syrah with a strong sense of place.

The less successful wines, meanwhile, were often characterised by fruit left too long on the vine and then overworked in the cellar. As a result, they lacked vibrancy and came across as tired. Of particular concern was the noticeable presence of the spoilage yeast Brettanomyces, which appeared far more often that it has in recent times.

The average price of the 36 wines to rate 90-plus is R284 a bottle and of the Top 10 is R237. Offering the best quality relative to price is the De Wet 2023 with a rating of 91 and selling for R76 a bottle.

Riebeek Valley Wine Co, as producer of the wine judged best overall, wins a set of Nachtmann glasses worth R2,500 from warewashing specialist Winterhalter.



TOP 10 TASTING NOTES



De Grendel Op Die Berg Syrah 2023

Price: R355

Total Production: 19 200 bottles Abv 13.52%

50% whole-bunch fermentation. Matured for 12 months in second-, third- and fourth-fill barrels. Overtly fragrant with notes of red berries, fynbos, flowers and white pepper. Exceptional purity and poise – concentrated fruit, fresh acidity and powdery tannins, the finish dry and persistent.





Klein Amoskuil Die Nagmuis Bush Vine Syrah 2023

Price: R235

Total Production: 3 750 bottles and 52 magnums Abv 13.14%

Matured for 10 months in old oak. Pretty aromatics of floral perfume, tea leaf, and fynbos, followed by red berries and a hint of olive brine. The palate is beautifully structured without being overpowering, offering succulent fruit, bright acidity, and fine powdery tannins. A vivid and expressive wine.





Raar | Best Overall Carbonic Maceration 2024 (Riebeek Valley Wine Co)

Price: R165

Total Production: 3 333 bottles Abv 13.5%

100% whole-bunch fermentation. Matured for eight months in older 500-litre barrels. Gorgeous aromatics of violets, fynbos, red and black berries, orange, olive brine and white pepper. The palate has excellent fruit purity, vibrant acidity and lacy tannins, the finish long and dry.







Glenelly Glass Collection Syrah 2022

Price: R180

Total Production: 74 900 bottles Abv 14.36%

Partial whole-bunch fermentation. Matured for 12 months in older 500-litre barrels. Red and black berries, lavender, pomegranate and pepper. Medium bodied with good freshness and tightly knit tannins, the finish deeply savoury.





Groot Phesantekraal Syrah 2023

Price: R185

Total Production: 14 000 bottles Abv 13.96%

20% whole-bunch fermentation. Matured for 12 months in barrel, 20% new - 92% French and 8% American oak. Red and black berries, fynbos, rose and pepper on the nose while the palate is marked by succulent fruit, bright acidity and crunchy tannins. Pure and energetic - juicy and fresh, yet not lacking in weight.





Kasteelberg Syrah 2024 (Riebeek Valley Wine Co)

Price: R260

Total Production: 3 340 bottles Abv 13.5%

30% whole-bunch fermentation. Matured for nine months in older oak. Red and black berries, floral perfume, and a hint of cured meat on the nose. Pure and vibrant, with good fruit density, supple tannins, and a dry finish. A well-balanced, seamless wine.





Stellenbosch Reserve Kruithuis Syrah 2022

Price: R200

Total Production: 17 000 bottles Abv 14.31%

Partial whole-bunch fermentation. Matured for 16 months in older barrels. Red and black berries, floral perfume, fynbos, pepper and a hint of vanilla on the nose. Good fruit weight, fresh acidity and pleasantly firm tannins. A well-balanced, polished wine.





Von The Sir 2023

Price: R200

Total Production: I 850 bottles Abv I4.8%

90% Shiraz, 10% Durif. 30% whole-bunch fermentation. Matured for 15 months in barrel, 17% new. Red and black berries, floral perfume, earth and pepper. The palate is dense and smooth textured in the best sense, yet retains freshness. Good fruit depth and powdery tannins.





De Grendel Op Die Berg Syrah 2022

Price: R355

Total Production: 15 600 bottles Abv 13.23%

50% whole-bunch fermentation. Matured for 12 months in second-, third- and fourth-fill barrels. Red berries, rose, and white pepper on the nose. The palate is light-bodied, with pure fruit, fresh acidity, and silky tannins. Delicate and charming.







Kleine Zalze Vineyard Selection Syrah 2022

Price: R230

Total Production: 70 784 bottles Abv I4%

Matured for 18 months in 300-litre barrels, 30% new. Heady aromatics of red and black berries, lilies, toast, and pepper. The palate is powerful, with dense fruit balanced by zesty acidity and a firmly austere finish. Polished, persistent, and compelling.



HONORABLE MENTIONS

Because final ratings are determined by averaging the scores of three judges, decimal places come into play. As a result, the following wines fell just short of the Top 10 on 93 points:
