

ABOUT THE WINEMAG.CO.ZA TASTING PROGRAMME 2025

Winemag.co.za will release a series of category reports throughout the year with Prescient Fund Services as sponsor. Each report is based on the outcome of a blind tasting of wines entered within a specific category.

A report includes key findings, tasting notes for the top wines, buyer's guide (wines ranked by quality relative to price) and scores on the 100-point quality scale for all wines entered. Upon publication, producers can purchase both Top 10 and regular rating stickers – consumers are encouraged to look out for these in the retail environment.

JUDGING PROCEDURES

The judging panel was chaired by me and further consisted of two trusted colleagues, Ndaba Dube, director of operations at the President Hotel in Cape Town, and Francois Rautenbach, wine and hospitality specialist.

Ratings were done according to the 100-point system, with final scores determined through discussion and retasting when necessary, rather than relying solely on arithmetic averages.

KEY FINDINGS

For this year's Pinotage Report sponsored by financial services company Prescient Fund Services, there were 48 entries from 32 producers with 25 (52%) rating 90-plus on the 100-point quality scale.

Pinotage may be marking its centenary this year, but it remains a category fraught with challenges. The panel tasted just under 50 wines and, tellingly, could only identify six that genuinely stirred excitement – falling short of the intended Top 10.

Finesse remains elusive for the variety, and rather than working with this reality, too many producers continue to push extraction and oak, resulting in wines that are coarse and clumsy. Pinotage's historical vulnerability to technical faults is also still apparent. Its naturally high pH leaves it prone to oxidation, and too many examples appeared malty, excessively earthy, and simply fatigued.

Winemag.co.za has no intention of prescribing a singular stylistic path – it is still very much a work in progress in a global context – but it does seem that some fresh thinking needs to be brought to bear.

The average price of the 25 wines to rate 90-plus is R305 a bottle and of the Top 10 is R345. Offering the best quality relative to price is Charles Lang & Sons 2023 with a rating of 93 and selling for R65 a bottle.

Illimis, as producer of the wine judged best overall, wins an energy audit, 12-month monitoring, and grid optimization support worth approximately R10 000 from Evolve Battery & Grid Solutions.



TOP SIX TASTING NOTES



Illimis 2024

Price: R305

Total production: 5 940 bottles Abv 13.5%

80% whole-bunch fermentation. Matured for seven months in older 225-litre barrels. A wonderfully fragrant nose with notes of dark cherry, pomegranate, violets and herbs. The palate has a striking coherence about it – light-bodied but equally pure and poised, the finish crunchy. Impresses with its energy and precision.





Allée Bleue 2023

Price: R225

Total production: 6 000 bottles Abv 14.2%

Grapes from Bottelary, Stellenbosch. Matured for 16 months in barrel, 55% new. Floral perfume, plums, red and black cherry, vanilla, oak spice and touch of earth on the nose while the palate is well structured – good fruit clarity, fresh acidity and firm but not coarse tannins.





Hasher Family Batrachella 2023

Price: R590

Total production: 3 262 bottles Abv 13.34%

Matured for 11 months in 228-litre barrels, 10% new. Red and black berries, flowers, herbs and earth on the nose. Succulent fruit, lemon-like acidity and tannins that are perhaps slightly unyielding now but suggest this will reward time in bottle. A wine of quiet power.





Springfontein Terroir Selection 2022

Price: R275

Total production: 10 755 bottles Abv 13.5%

Matured for 20 months, 30% in second- and 70% in third-fill barrels. Exuberant aromatics of cranberry, raspberry, fynbos, pomegranate, earth, and spice. The palate is elegant and finely detailed, with excellent fruit clarity, bright acidity, and powdery tannins.





Charles Lang & Sons 2023

Price: R65

Total production: 26 000 bottles Abv I4%

Grapes from Paarl. Matured for 12 months in third- and fourth-fill barrels. Precociously primary and pretty on the nose with notes of flowers, herbs and red berries. The palate is wonderfully approachable with lots of clean, sweet fruit offset by fresh acidity and powdery tannins. Great fun.





Warwick The Black Lady 2023

Price: R610

Total production: 9 253 bottles Abv 14%

Matured for 14 months in barrel, 13% new. Appealing if somewhat restrained daromatics of flowers, herbs, and cherry. The palate may be subtle in flavour but impresses with its purity, balance, and beautifully supple texture. Medium-bodied and fresh with a nicely dry finish.
