# ABOUT THE WINEMAG.CO.ZA TASTING PROGRAMME 2026

Winemag.co.za will release a series of category reports throughout the year with Prescient Fund Services as sponsor. Each report is based on the outcome of a blind tasting of wines entered within a specific category.

A report includes key findings, tasting notes for the top wines, buyer's guide (wines ranked by quality relative to price) and scores on the 100-point quality scale for all wines entered. Upon publication, producers can purchase both Top 10 and regular rating stickers – consumers are encouraged to look out for these in the retail environment.

The tasting programme is further supported by partners Aspiring Couriers, Getwine and Winterhalter.

## INTRODUCTION

The Minority Report focuses on wines made from grape varieties with total plantings of 5,000 hectares or less. South Africa's seven most widely planted varieties – Chenin Blanc, Sauvignon Blanc, Colombar, Cabernet Sauvignon, Shiraz, Pinotage and Chardonnay – all exceed this threshold, while the eighth, Merlot, falls just short at 4,907 hectares. Together, the Big Eight account for 81.5% of the national vineyard, leaving lesser-known varieties easily overlooked – this is their moment to step into the spotlight.

## JUDGING PROCEDURES

The white varieties panel was chaired by me and included Ndaba Dube, director of operations, President Hotel, Cape Town, and Jolette Steyn-Prior, head of sales and imports at merchant Brice & Burnett.

The red varieties panel comprised me, Dube and Lauren Seegers-Jewell, SA buyer and sales manager at Brice & Burnett.

Ratings were done according to the 100-point system, with final scores determined through discussion and retasting when necessary, rather than relying solely on arithmetic averages.

# KEY FINDINGS

For this year's Minority Report, sponsored by financial services company Prescient Fund Services, 33 white wine and 52 red wine entries were entered – a total of 85 wines from 48 producers. Of these, 26 whites (79%) and 44 reds (85%) scored 90-plus on the 100-point quality scale.

What stands out most this year is not novelty, but the emergence of a distinct grouping of alternative varieties alongside the mainstream core. Alternative varieties are no longer marginal experiments; they are entirely credible in their own right – albeit with a still-narrow consumer base.

## 1. Quality is increasingly beyond dispute

This year's results show a substantial cluster of 90+ wines across both white and red categories, with a small elite tier at 94. This confirms that alternative varieties are now capable of consistent fine-wine performance, particularly in Semillon, Grenache Blanc, Grenache Noir, Cinsault, Pinot Noir and Cabernet Franc.

## 2. Stylistic convergence is reinforcing category identity

Despite genetic diversity, the wines increasingly share a recognisable stylistic frame: fresh acidity and moderate alcohol, yielding a profile defined by detail, texture and savoury character. Whole-bunch fermentation, large-format oak, concrete and amphora are now standard tools rather than experimental choices. The result is not homogenisation, but a coherent "Cape restraint" aesthetic across varieties.

## 3. The Big Eight remain dominant – but no longer exclusive in defining quality

The Big Eight still account for the vast majority of vineyard plantings and retail volume, and they continue to anchor the market structurally. However, alternative varieties are increasingly capable of matching or exceeding quality benchmarks in specific sites and hands. The shift is therefore not displacement, but quality pluralisation.

## 4. The key commercial question: who actually drinks these wines?

At present, the consumer base for alternative varieties remains small, educated and highly engaged – typically sommeliers, collectors, wine trade professionals and curious premium consumers. These wines are not yet mainstream purchases; they are discovery-driven rather than habitual buys.

This creates a structural challenge: the category is critically strong but demand-constrained. Unlike Sauvignon Blanc or Cabernet Sauvignon, alternative varieties do not yet benefit from mass recognition, global category familiarity, or entrenched consumption occasions.

## 5. Value distortion remains a defining feature

Pricing is still imperfectly aligned with quality. Several top-performing wines remain accessible, while others reflect brand positioning more than intrinsic differentiation. This reinforces the idea that alternative varieties are still in a price-discovery phase, particularly outside established producer names.

## 6. Commercial relevance depends on three pathways

For alternative varieties to scale beyond their current niche, three mechanisms matter:

- On-trade influence (restaurants and wine bars): where discovery and recommendation drive trial
- Producer-led storytelling and identity building: varietal and site narratives that replace familiarity with curiosity
- Price-value advantage: continued strong quality-to-price ratios that encourage repeat purchase once discovered

Without these, the category risks remaining “admired but not habitual.”

## Bottom line

The most important insight is that alternative varieties are not struggling on quality – they are struggling on consumer habit formation. The wines are technically and intellectually successful, but commercially they remain dependent on recommendation ecosystems rather than organic demand.

### Wildeberg | Best Overall White 2023

Price: R459

Total Production: 1,470 bottles Abv 12.55%

*From a Franschhoek vineyard planted in 1905. Matured for nine months in Austrian oak, 50% new. Thatch, citrus, stone fruit and wax on the nose. The palate is rich yet balanced – concentrated fruit and bright acidity before a gently savoury finish. Full of flavour.*



### Hazendal White Blend 2025

Price: R395

Total Production: 3,000 bottles Abv 13.11%

*54% Roussanne, 46% Marsanne. Matured for 11 months in predominantly clay pots but also older oak. Compelling aromatics of floral perfume, fynbos, pear, peach, citrus and some flinty reduction. The palate is taut and energetic – good fruit clarity, snappy acidity and a pithy finish. Plenty of nuance even at this early stage.*



### Donkiesbaai Grenache Blanc 2025

Price: R389

Total Production: 5,850 bottles Abv 13.9%

*60% in older 500-litre barrels, 30% in concrete eggs, and 10% in clay amphorae. Blossom, fynbos, pear, peach and citrus on the nose. Good weight and energy – concentrated fruit matched by zesty acidity, the finish long and dry. Precisely made.*

### Perdeberg | Best Overall The Vineyard Collection Grenache Noir 2024

Price: R129

Total Production: 14,086 bottles Abv 13.52%

*Matured for 12 months in older oak. Red and black berries, fynbos and pepper on the nose. Succulent fruit, bright acidity and chalky tannins. Intensely flavoured without sacrificing vibrancy.*



### Cirrus Pinot Noir 2024

Price: R389

Total Production: 7,200 bottles Abv 13.15%

*From clones PN 115 and PN 777. 30% whole-bunch fermented. Matured for 14 months in older 500-litre barrels. Red and black cherry, crushed herbs, spice and some earthiness. The palate is structured and well-balanced – pure fruit, fresh acidity and tannins that are none too soft. The finish, meanwhile, is lengthy and dry.*



### Flagstone The Bugler's Call Grenache Noir 2024

Price: R175

Total Production: 2,500 bottles Abv 14.5%

*95% of grapes from Wellington, 5% Swartland. 90% Grenache Noir, 5% Petite Sirah, 5% Shiraz. Matured for five months in older oak. Complex aromatics of red and black berries, orange, olive, fynbos and musk. Medium bodied with good fruit definition, fresh acidity and powdery tannins. Subtle and refined.*





## Hazendal Carignan 2025

Price: R995 (1.5L)

Total Production: 460 magnums Abv 13.68%

*15% whole-bunch fermented. Matured for 11 months in one 500-litre barrel. Red and black berries, flowers, fynbos and white pepper on the nose. The palate is medium bodied, intense but still graceful. Flavourful, vital and resolutely dry on the finish.*



## Wildeberg Terroirs Cinsault 2025

Price: R329

Total Production: 4,407 bottles Abv 12.72%

*30% whole-bunch fermentation. Matured for nine months in 500- and 600-litre barrels. 30% new. A touch of reduction precedes notes of cherry, musk, fynbos and spice. Relatively full-bodied, with bright acidity and firm yet supple tannins, it has an appealing vinosity.*



## Koelenbosch Sangiovese 2023

Price: R109

Total Production: 8,794 bottles Abv 13.14%

*Matured for 18 months in second-fill barrels. Red berries, floral perfume and spice on the nose. The palate is medium bodied with good structural integrity – pure fruit, fresh acidity and fine-grained tannins. Delicious!*



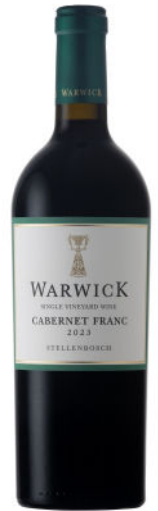


## Warwick Cabernet Franc 2023

Price: R675

Total Production: 4,223 bottles Abv 14.5%

*Matured for 21 months in barrel, 40% new. Plum, cassis, fynbos, pencil shavings and vanilla on the nose. The palate is dense and smooth textured. Good flavour intensity, the finish dry and persistent. A serious proposition.*
